

He writes that "cancer can weaken your immune system, but cancer cannot weaken your relationships". This is just one of the many true and inspiring phrases that can be found in this book.

Darryn's positive view of life is reflected in his writing and the Western Cape Transplant Sports Association is proud to have him as part of our team. He is one of the athletes that will

represent South Africa in June 2017 at the World Transplant Games in Spain where he will compete in the long jump event. Darryn allowed himself to dream big and can surely be proud of a well written and inspirational book.
