



QUALIFYING FOR WORLD TRANSPLANT GAMES

POLICY: RE-QUALIFYING PERIOD AGE GROUP DIFFERENCES FOR NATIONAL TRANSPLANT GAMES AND WORLD TRANSPLANT GAMES

NOTE: This policy links to the Selection Policy for athletes to the World Transplant Games (WTG).

The Rules of the Games for the National Transplant Games (NTG) and the World Transplant Games stipulate the following:

“Age on the day of the Opening Ceremony of the Games will apply”

In the case where an athlete participates in one age group at the NTG but will participate in another age group at the WTG, the following will apply relating to the **re-qualifying period**:

1. At the National Transplant Games (NTG) the athlete will compete in the age-group on the day of the Opening Ceremony.
This specification also applies for athletes who are given an **Extra Opportunity** to qualify (within 10% of standard at NTG) as well as those who applied for **Extra-Ordinary Opportunity** to qualify.
The Selection Committee will consider the different age group category for the WTG in which the athlete will compete when evaluating performance.
2. In the re-qualifying period, the athlete will have to qualify in the age group he/she will be competing in the WTG.
